



Works Overview

- Construct new 75 mm high raised table.
- Mark hump triangles.
- Adjust existing kerbing to accommodate raised table and lay flush.
- Install buff coloured blister tactile paving.
- Construct new 2 m wide footway (approx. 40 m) from raised table to existing footway on Ballingry Crescent.
- Relocate 20 zone signs and street nameplate.
- Remove existing bollard and edge kerb frame.
- Construct new dropped kerb crossing point at Ballingry Crescent junction including buff coloured blister tactile paving.

Key

- Construct Footway Type F1 to standard detail CS/SD11/28A.
- Carriageway to be reinstated using an A2 patch to standard detail C9 A1/A.
- Install K3/1 Bullnose kerb (flush) to standard detail CS/SD11/03.
- Install K5 Transition kerb to standard detail CS/SD11/04.
- Install E1 Edge kerb to standard detail CS/SD11/14.
- Existing concrete Half-batter kerb.
- Install BUFF coloured blister tactile paving to standard detail CS/SD11/53.

Safety Notes
 Road is a single carriageway "B" class road with 30 mph.
 Risk of striking underground services - see attached Public Utility plans. PUs indicatively drawn.
 There may be other services present and the Contractor shall take appropriate measures to locate them.

Notes
 Raised table to be 75 mm high and to standard detail CS/SD11/38.
 Road hump triangles to be marked as shown to Dia. 1062.
 Road markings to be laid in white thermoplastic screed and reflectorised with glass beads in accordance with Table 12-1 of TSM Chapter 5 2019.
 Dropped crossing to standard detail CS/SD11/37.
 See attached Post and Foundation Design for 20 zone signs.
 Sign edge must be minimum 0.45 m from carriageway edge.

*Reuse existing materials where possible.
 Unusable materials to be removed to tip off site.*
