Regard given to the Local Development Plan

The Fife Plan adopted in 2017 highlighted one area of housing in Hall Park which has been completed.

Regard given to the National Planning Framework

Throughout the accompanying Largoward & District CC, reference is made to Scotland's National Planning Framework 4 (NPF4) which was published in 2023 and sets out spatial principles, regional priorities, national developments and national planning policy.

Regard given to any relevant Locality Plan

One of the desired outcomes of the NE Fife Rural Poverty Action Plan 2023-2026 is to "Increase accessibility to services throughout NE Fife to address transport costs and poor transport links". Transport was a key focus area given consideration in the LPP. Largoward village has no services. The district is served by the Go-Flexi and a limited scheduled bus service. There is no scheduled evening and Sunday service. This limits access to employment and leisure opportunities and perpetuates the need to own a car.

Reasons for amendments being sought to the Local Development Plan

The LPP does not request any amendments to the LDP.

Community support for the Local Place Plan

A full survey was conducted and an in-person drop in session held to gather opinions and suggestions for the LPP. A summary of findings is included in the LPP. Feedback was sought on the final draft of the LPP. All feedback received to the draft is included in the appendices of the LPP.
