The documents will also be available online at www.fife.gov.uk/notices Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from 12/09/24, apply to the Court of Session for that purpose.

The Order will be in operation for an experimental period of 18 months. The Council will in due course be considering whether the provisions of the Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Any person may object to the making of the order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation by writing to Traffic Management, Roads & Transportation Service, Bankhead Central, Bankhead Park, Glenrothes, Fife KY7 6GH or by e-mail to traffic.management@fife.gov.uk within a period of 6 months beginning on 01/10/24 or, if the Order is subsequently varied or modified, the latest date on which such variation or modification comes into force.

THE FIFE COUNCIL (HIGH STREET, KIRKCALDY) (PARKING RESTRICTION) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2024

The Fife Council ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 9 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police for the Council's area in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Fife Council (High Street, Kirkcaldy) (Parking Restriction) Experimental Order 2024" and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October 2024 and shall remain in operation for a period of 18 months.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
