

## **THE FIFE COUNCIL (VARIOUS STREETS, NEWBURGH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2025**

Fife Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce speed limits on the lengths of road in Newburgh as follows:- 20 m.p.h. speed limit – **Cupar Rd (A913)** Entire length; **High St (A913)** Entire length; **Abernethy Rd (A913)** From High St southwesterly for approx. 282m; **Abbey Rd** From A913 northeasterly for approx. 230m and **Land North of Cupar Rd (A913)** All roads constructed or to be constructed within new housing development site. 40 m.p.h. speed limit – **Abernethy Rd (A913)** From approx. 282m southwest of High St southwesterly for approx. 372m.

**THE FIFE COUNCIL (VARIOUS STREETS, NEWBURGH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2025**

The Fife Council (“the Council”) in exercise of the powers conferred on them under sections 84(1) and 124(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police for the Council’s area in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Fife Council (Various Streets, Newburgh) (Speed Limits) Order 2025” and shall come into operation on the day of **Two Thousand and Twenty Five.**
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which falls within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
5. Drawing numbers TRO24\_50a and TRO24\_50b showing the roads affected by this Order delineated in black are annexed and signed as relative hereto.

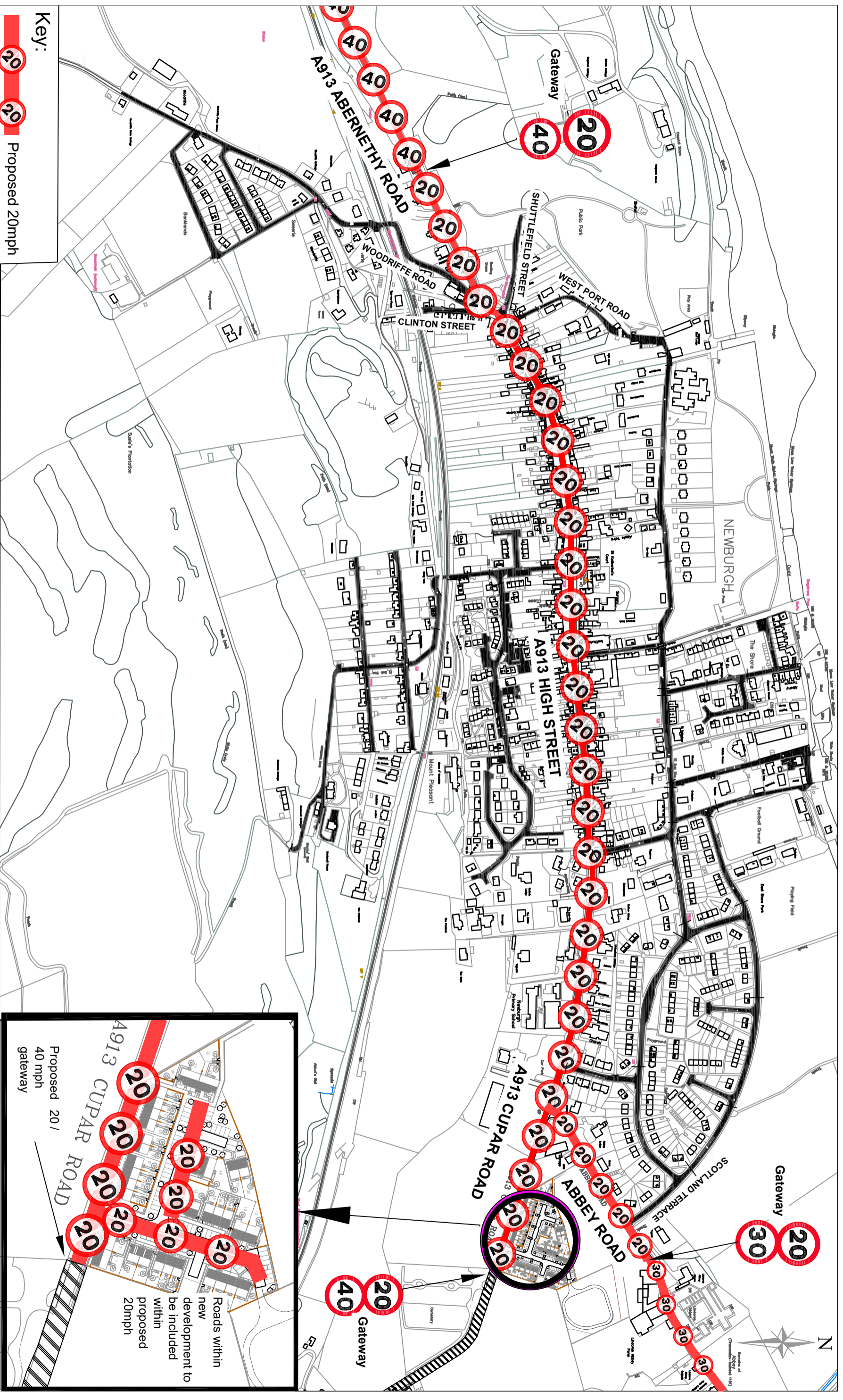

The proposed 20mph speed limit will apply to the entire stretch of the current 30mph zone on the A913 in Newburgh. Additionally, it will extend along Abbey Road from its junction with the A913 to the entrance of the Lindores Abbey car park. The new development north of the A913 Cupar Road will also be included within this 20mph zone.
