The Fife Council ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred on them under sections 84(1) and 124(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police for the Council's area in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Fife Council (Various Streets, Newburgh) (Speed Limits) Order 2025" and shall come into operation on the day of Two Thousand and Twenty Five.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which falls within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 5. Drawing numbers TRO24_50a and TRO24_50b showing the roads affected by this Order delineated in black are annexed and signed as relative hereto.
