# THE FIFE COUNCIL (B921 AND BLYTHE MEADOW HOUSING ESTATE, KINGLASSIE) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2025

The Fife Council ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred on them under sections 84(1) and 124(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police for the Council's area in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Fife Council (B921 and Blythe Meadow Housing Estate, Kinglassie) (Speed Limits) Order 2024" and shall come into operation on the Tenth day of March, Two Thousand and Twenty Five.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. The Fife Council (B921 Glenrothes to Kinglassie 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2004 shall be revoked entirely.
- 5. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which falls within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 6. Drawing numbers TRO/24/45-EXIS and TRO/24/45-PROP showing the roads affected by this Order delineated in black are annexed and signed as relative hereto
