Abbotshall Road, Forth Avenue, Oriel Road (Northbound from Forth Avenue to Bennoch Road), Oriel Road (Full closure from Bennoch Road to Torbain Road), Wester Bogie Road (Southbound from Torbain Road to Chapel Level), Chapel Level (Westbound lane closure), Dunnikier Way (from Chapel Level to Rosemount), Rosemount (from Dunnikier Way to Johnny Marshalls Loan), Johnny Marshalls Loan (from Rosemount to Oswald House), Dunnikier Way, Carberry Road, Midfield Road, Mitchelston Drive, Caxton Place, Oswald Road, York Place, Windmill Road, Townhead (from Windmill Road to West Port), West Port, Quality Street, Cross Street, Victoria Street, Nether Street, The Walk, Pan Ha', Shore Road, Hot Pot Wynd, West Quality Street, Dysart Road (from West Quality Street to Ravenscraig Park, then St Clair Street), Nether Street, The Path (Westbound), High Street (from The Path to The Esplanade), Esplanade, Gas Wynd, Links Street (from Gas Wynd to Milton Road) and Milton Road.
