Refurbishment of Lochgelly South Primary School May 2024 Update

Welcome to our second newsletter with updates on our progress of the refurbishment at Lochgelly South Primary School. As we reported in January all grouting works are complete and work has moved to the internal refurbishment of the school. Work has been progressing at pace and we are pleased to bring you an update on our progress.

Internally we have progressed well with the re-wiring of the school and the installation of the new heating system. The classroom floors and walls have been completed bringing them up to modern standards. All equipment has been stripped out from the kitchen awaiting the installation of a new modern facility which will be commissioned within the next 6 weeks.

Externally we have moved our site compound to the rear of the site to allow work to start on the new car park.

The following activities are planned over the next few months. Internal:

- Work to complete all the electrical and mechanical enhancements.
- Fit replacement doors and skirtings.
- Kitchen and dining hall works will continue.
- Start the installation of suspended ceilings.
- Replacement heating services.
- Toilet upgrades will commence.
- Installation of the new purpose-built learning walls which will provide classroom storages as well as an interactive TV in every teaching area.


External Works and Services:

- Completion of the installation of the power and internet infrastructure.
- Completion of the repairs to the roof. Once finished scaffolding will be removed and external painting can commence.
- New surfacing to the playground and play areas.
- Installation of the modular nursery unit including associated groundworks and services will commence early May.
