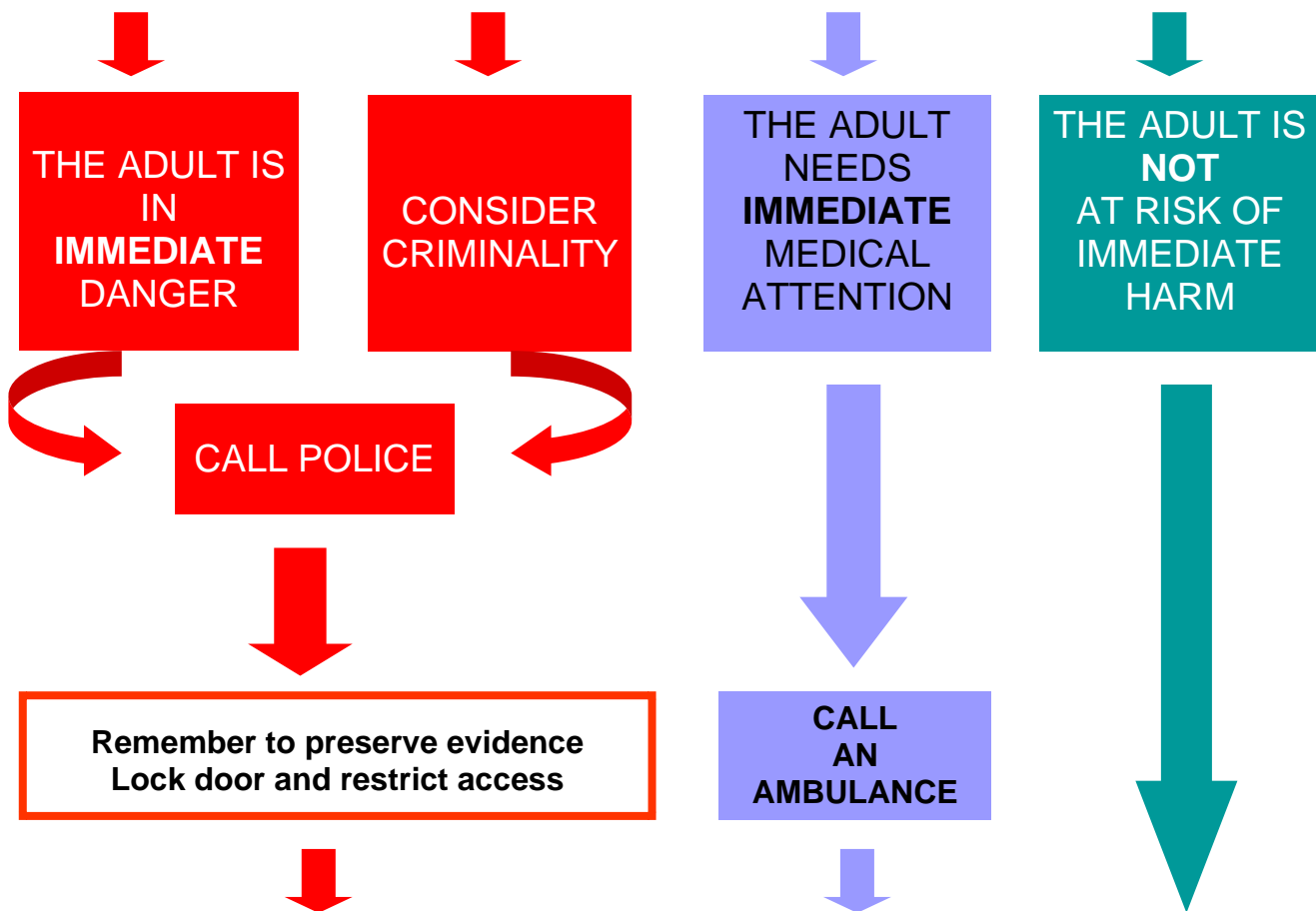

INFORMATION RECEIVED

You suspect an adult is being harmed
You have seen an adult being harmed
An adult has told you they are being harmed

What is harm? Who is an adult at risk of harm?

Immediately call Social Work Contact Centre on 01383 602200
Or contact allocated social worker (if known)

IN ALL CASES

You have a duty to report harm, even if the adult does not want you to.
It is good practice to inform the adult that you are reporting harm.
Inform your line manager and follow your organisation's
Adult Protection procedures
Complete a Report of Harm referral form

Police ONLY— Complete a Vulnerable Person Report - Adult at Risk
Fire Service ONLY - Complete AP1 Form Adult at Risk
