Being a good neighbour & visitor in Fife

A guide to unauthorised camping in Fife, what is expected of people and how Fife Council can help you.

Respect the area



- ✓ **DO** respect the land that the camp is on.
- ✓ **DO** dispose of your household rubbish responsibly. Use the local recycling centres or make it easy for our staff to collect your rubbish bags.
- ✓ **DO** get rid of your animal and human waste safely and responsibly.
- ✓ **DO** leave the area clean and as you found it.
- ✗ **DON'T** leave a mess.

✗ **DON'T** 'fly-tip' your rubbish – get rid of commercial waste at one of our Commercial Waste Recycling Centres.

✗ **DON'T** risk 'out-of-control' fires by not having fires.

Respect others



- ✓ **DO** show respect to others who live nearby - including their peace of mind (for example don't act in ways that might annoy or alarm others).
- ✓ **DO** work positively with us.
- ✓ **DO** take responsibility for your own actions.
- ✓ **DO** keep pets quiet and under control.
- ✓ **DO** respect the rights, and way of life, of others who use the land.
- ✓ **DO** If possible, let us know when you arrive to camp (if you don't have the landowner's permission already). This will help us provide services you may need.

✗ **DON'T** keep large groups – avoid having too many vehicles in one place.

✗ **DON'T** create a nuisance with noise - for example, from your generators.
