THE FIFE COUNCIL (DISABLED PERSONS' OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2024

The Fife Council ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 32 and 35 of and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police for the Council's area in accordance with paragraph 20(1) of Schedule 9 to the said Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Fife Council (Disabled Persons' Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No 1) Order 2024" and shall come into operation on the 8th day of July 2024.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
