Fife Licensing Forum – Convener’s Annual Report 2023-24

The forum has failed to hold the required number of meetings this year. This has continued a trend over the last couple of years and it comes down to the lack of a quorum. Despite the issues related to a lack of quorum the forum decided to increase membership in the hope that new entrants would be more committed and relied upon to attend meetings. In the Fife licensing board annual functions report 2022/2023 it was noted that the forum ‘has not made any recommendations or given advice to the Board that has not been considered by the Board, during the period being considered by this report.’

It is with regret that we should note the passing of John Barclay. John was one of the founding members of the forum and he could always be relied upon to attend and contribute opinions. He was the first chair of the forum and he would be the chair again as recently as 2022. John was driven by hospitality and created welcoming environments both at East Fife Football club, The Fife Licensing Forum and the License Trade Association. On a personal level, John was very supportive and thoughtful when sharing advice on how to chair the meetings and the purpose of the forum. We wish his friends and family the greatest sympathy in this challenging time.

The number of challenges encountered by the license trade over the last 12 months has been numerous and the list below is not an exhaustive but a best attempt at the key issues,

- Increase in business rates in the Fife area through the re-evaluation in 1/4/23. In conjunction with this the Small Business Bonus Scheme (SBBS) has dropped from £15k to £12k reducing the amount that could be claimed.
- The continued high cost of energy while the government downscaled the support available in September 2023. As recently as January 2024 the Federation of small businesses identified a [‘12-fold increase in standing charges’](#)
- The increase in duty for alcohol resulting in a higher cost of alcohol
- The Scottish Government white paper proposal for the restriction of alcohol advertising
- The fall out from the failure of the Deposit Return Scheme
- The Cost of living crisis has put continued pressure on the public spending
- The UK entering recession at the end of 2023 again place further reduction in consumer spending
- The highest interests rates for 16 years, increasing the cost of borrowing for businesses

In conjunction with this the forum must acknowledge the increase in alcohol related deaths in Fife have increased continually since 2020. Further to this, you would be 4.8 times more likely to die of alcohol related death in a deprived area.

The rate of alcohol-related hospital admissions fell in 2022/23 compared to 2021/22 in Fife and Scotland but rates in Fife remained higher than the national rate which has been the situation since 2018/19. Again, within Fife's most deprived areas you would 5.4 times more likely to be admitted to hospital with an alcohol related admission compared to a less deprived area.

In regard to the licensed premises the figures for the year to 31 March 2024 will be published by the end of June so they will not appear in this report. However, we can use data from 2022/2023 report but the operation of licensed premises was still partially restricted in this period due to Covid-19 restrictions in place throughout some of the reporting period.

There was a decrease in personal license holders believed to be due to an increase in licenses being revoked under the 2005 Act due to not undertaking and submitting evidence of refresher training that despite the Covid 19 extension. There was a decrease of 3 licensed premises.

Going forward the trade will need to face the challenges with the minimum unit price increase which disproportionately impacts on trade premises, potential duty increases on alcohol, a growing trend of lower alcohol consumption, potential restrictions in alcohol advertising while attempting to reducing the continued growth trend in alcohol deaths and the alarming role of deprivation in exacerbating alcohol related concerns.

12. WELCOME AND APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

The Convener, Gregor Hannah, welcomed everyone to the meeting, noted apologies and acknowledged the recent retirement of Elizabeth Mair, Committee Officer, Fife Council. On behalf of the Forum, the Convener thanked Elizabeth for her valued support to the members of the Forum.

13. MINUTE

The Forum:-

- (a) considered the minutes of the meeting of the Fife Licensing Forum on 24 August 2023 and 18 September 2023; and
- (b) noted that the minutes from the meeting of the Fife Licensing Forum on 25 May 2023, had not been approved and agreed to also consider those minutes.

Decision

The Forum agreed to approve the minutes of the meetings on 25 May, 24 August and 18 September 2023.

14. APPOINTMENT OF NEW MEMBERS

The Forum considered a report by the Head of Legal and Democratic Services seeking agreement to appoint new members to the Forum, following agreement at the meeting of Fife Council on 22 June 2023, to increase the membership from 15 to 18 members.

The Forum has a current membership of 12 members and 6 vacancies. Five persons had expressed an interest in joining the Forum, the report provided a brief outline of their interests and relevant experience.

Decision

The Forum agreed to appoint 5 new members:- Susanna Galea-Singer, Addiction Services NHS Fife; Peter Reid, Fife resident; Morag Douglas - Licence Holder; James Torrance - Licence Holder; and Helen Hutton, FASS, Health and Social Care Partnership.

15. CHIEF CONSTABLE'S ANNUAL REPORT 1 APRIL 2022 - 31 MARCH 2023

The Forum considered the Chief Constable's Annual Licensing Report for the period 2022/23.

Decision

The Forum noted the contents of the report.

16. POLICE REPORT

Neil Ewing, Licensing Sergeant Police Scotland, provided an update on the work of the Police since the last meeting. He advised that joint visits had been carried out with the licensing standards officers to premises where issues had been highlighted and provided advice as required. Positive engagement continued with licensed premises, with Police supporting both Dunfermline and Kirkcaldy Pub Watch Schemes, in preparation for the busy festive period during December.

Decision

The Forum noted the update.

17. LICENSING STANDARDS OFFICERS UPDATE

Douglas Hardaker advised that recruitment was underway for a new Licensing Standards Officer following a resignation from the current officer. The team had been carrying out visits to small shops over the past couple of months and noted a rise in the number of shops that had introduced operating plans in their premises.

Decision

The Forum:-

- (1) noted the update;
- (2) raised concerns that delivery drivers had either no training or inadequate training when supplying or selling alcohol which could result in individuals under 18 years of age accepting orders of alcohol; and
- (3) following a discussion, agreed the Chair of the Forum would contact the Fife Licensing Board and Scottish Ministers to highlight the concerns raised by the Forum for the requirement of training for delivery drivers when supplying/selling alcohol.

18. PUBLIC HEALTH UPDATE

The Forum considered a report by Catherine Chudleigh, Public Health Consultant, NHS Fife, providing an update on the following:-

- impact of overprovision in Fife through detailed analysis of the provision and harms associated with Alcohol in Fife, several areas had been identified where alcohol provision and harms were high, recommendations had been submitted to the Licensing Board but not upheld;
- detailed response was submitted to the Alcohol Licensing Statement consultation, identifying opportunities for strengthening the statement in relation to the public health objective; consideration on work to reduce harms associated with alcohol in communities with the affected by the highest rates of alcohol related harm in Fife;
- a summary report on Substance Use in Fife;
- Fife ADP Stakeholder engagement event; and
- completion of a detailed review of alcohol specific deaths, a report would be brought to the Forum in due course for discussion.

Decision

The Forum noted the updates.

19. UPDATES FROM FIFE LICENSING BOARD

The Forum considered the Lists of Decisions from the Fife Licensing Board meetings on 21 August and 2 October 2023.

20. MEETING DATES FOR 2024

The members of the Forum discussed future meetings of the Forum in 2024, including whether the day and time of future meetings should be altered, to assist in securing a quorum to allow business to be transacted.

Decision

The Forum:-

- (1) agreed to continue to hold meetings on a Thursday at 2pm; and
- (2) noted that the Committee Officer would circulate dates for meetings in 2024 to all members of the Forum.

21. ALCOHOL FOCUS SCOTLAND - EFOCUS NEWSLETTERS

The Forum noted that eFocus newsletters could be accessed directly through the Alcohol Focus Scotland Website, a link to the newsletters was also provided for members use.

22. ANY OTHER COMPETENT BUSINESS

Following a discussion on Minimum Unit Pricing, it was suggested MUP could be an increased which would aid in the decrease of alcohol consumption, concerns were raised that there would be risk that users would find other means of substance abuse as a substitute.

POLICE SCOTLAND UPDATE

One retail premises has been reported for a review of their liquor licence due to selling to someone under 18. Issues with groups of youths, many fuelled by alcohol.

Campaign will be running again to target proxy sales and local officers being deployed to hot spot areas. Regular visits to premises are carried out, whereby issues are highlighted. Several visits were carried out as a joint visit along with Licensing Standards Officers.

Kirkcaldy Annual Links Market will take place from 17 April 2024. Many issues are caused with youths congregating, buying alcohol and anti-social behaviour. Local officers will be deployed throughout the market in and around the bus station, High Street and Links Street in Kirkcaldy. Visits will be made to local shops and pubs prior to the event to highlight the issues and repercussions with selling alcohol to persons under 18.

Moving ahead joint meetings are currently taking place with Police Scotland, Fife Council, R&A in preparation for the Woman's Open Golf in St Andrews.

Initial meetings have also taken place with local officers regarding a large Fan Zone at East End Park, Dunfermline for the Euro Championships this summer.
